John:1:1: In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

Psalms:93:5: Thy testimonies are very sure: holiness becometh thine house, O LORD, for ever.

Gen:26:5: Because that Abraham obeyed my voice, and kept my charge, my commandments, my statutes, and my laws.

Nehemiah 9:13: Thou camest down also upon mount Sinai, and spakest with them from heaven, and gavest them right judgments, and true laws, good statutes and commandments:

Psalms:119:160: Thy word is true from the beginning: and every one of **thy righteous judgments** endureth for ever.

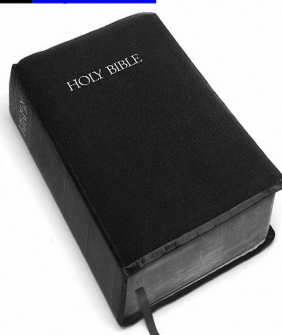
Psalms:119:161: Princes have persecuted me without a cause: but my heart standeth in awe of thy word.
