 - SPEAKING IN AN UNKNOWN TONGUE Edifying the church

The reason for this lesson is to show how the lord made his word simple to understand without adding or taking, but to study to show yourself approved, this lesson speaking in tongues, is broke down into 4 different sections, just to show the unlearned, that really want to learn, that speaking in tongues, is just speaking the languages that you are born with, or the nation you dwell in, just that simple, but not speaking in a unknown tongue, or babbling, some might say catching the holy ghost (this teaching is a traditon of man and not GOD, nor his prophets, or his apostles, but man twisting the lords holy scriptures and testimonies to their own destruction)

Gen11:7: Go to, let us go down, and there confound their language, that they may not understand one another's speech. 8: So the LORD scattered them abroad from thence upon the face of all the earth: and they left off to build the city. 9: Therefore is the name of it called Babel; because the LORD did there confound the language of all the earth: and from thence did the LORD scatter them abroad upon the face of all the earth.

1Cor 14: 21 In the law it is written, With men of other tongues and other lips will I speak unto this people; and yet for all that will they not hear me, saith the Lord.



Isa 28:11 For with stammering lips and another tongue will he speak to this people.

- Philip:2:10 That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth; 11: And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
- Isaiah 45:23 I have sworn by myself, the word is gone out of my mouth in righteousness, and shall not return, That unto me every knee shall bow, every tongue shall swear.
- Romans 14:11 For it is written, As I live, saith the Lord, every knee shall bow to me, and every tongue shall confess to God.
- Isaiah 66:18 For I know their works and their thoughts: it shall come, that I will gather all nations and tongues; and they shall come, and see my glory.

1 CORINTHIANS CHAPTER 14: BREAKDOWN SPEAKING IN AN UNKNOWN TONGUE Editiving the church

• 1Cor14:1: Follow after charity, and desire spiritual gifts, but rather that ye may prophesy. 2 For he that speaketh in an unknown tongue speaketh not unto men, but unto God: for no man understandeth him; howbeit in the spirit he speaketh mysteries.

1Cor13:2: And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries, and all knowledge; and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, and have not charity, I am nothing.

1Cor14:28: But if there be no interpreter, let him keep silence in the church; and let him speak to himself, and to
God.

• (if a person has no interpreter, that person need to keep silence and speak to God only)

• 1Cor 14:3: But he that prophesieth speaketh unto men to edification, and exhortation, and comfort. 4: He that speaketh in an unknown tongue edifieth himself; but he that prophesieth edifieth the church. 5: I would that ye all spake with tongues, but rather that ye prophesied: for greater is he that prophesieth than he that speaketh with tongues, except he interpret, that the church may receive edifying.12: Even so ye, for as much as ye are zealous of spiritual gifts, seek that ye may excel to the edifying of the church.

Rom14:19: Let us therefore follow after the things which make for peace, <u>and things wherewith one may edify</u> another.

Rom15:1: We then that are strong ought to bear the infirmities of the weak, and not to please ourselves. 2: Let every one of us please his neighbour for his good to edification.

(if a person is speaking in a unknown tongue that person must have a interpreter so the church may be edified)

• 1Cor14:6: Now, brethren, if I come unto you speaking with tongues, what shall I profit you, except I shall speak to you either by revelation, or by knowledge, or by prophesying, or by doctrine? 26: How is it then, brethren? when ye come together, every one of you hath a psalm, hath a doctrine, hath a tongue, hath a revelation, hath an interpretation. Let all things be done unto edifying.

2Pet 1:20: Knowing this first, that no prophecy of the scripture is of any private interpretation. 21: For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of God spake as they were moved by the Holy Ghost.

Eph:1:17: That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, <u>may</u> give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him:

• (let a man speak or prophesy in truth, and not by his own interpretation or doctrine)

1 CORINTHIANS CHAPTER 14: BREAKDOWN SPEAKING IN AN UNKNOWN TONGUE Editiving the church

1Cor 14:7: And even things without life giving sound, whether pipe or harp, except they give a distinction in the sounds, how shall it be known what is piped or harped? 8: For if the trumpet give an uncertain sound, who shall prepare himself to the battle? 9: So likewise ye, except ye utter by the tongue words easy to be understood, how shall it be known what is spoken? for ye shall speak into the air. 10: There are, it may be, so many kinds of voices in the world, and none of them is without signification. 11: Therefore if I know not the meaning of the voice, I shall be unto him that speaketh a barbarian, and he that speaketh shall be a barbarian unto me.



1Cor 13:1: Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, and have not charity, I am become as sounding brass, or a tinkling cymbal.

Rom 1:13: Now I would not have you ignorant, brethren, that oftentimes I purposed to come unto you, (but was let hitherto,) that I might have some fruit among you also, even as among other Gentiles. 14: I am debtor both to the Greeks, and to the Barbarians; both to the wise, and to the unwise. 15: So, as much as in me is, I am ready to preach the gospel to you that are at Rome also. 16: For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek. 17: For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from faith to faith: as it is written, The just shall live by faith.

- (their are many sounds of instruments, as for many nations of languages, each has a different tongues, but its all in vain, if a person can't understand the languages or recognize the sound), how shall it be known what is spoken? for ye shall speak into the air
- 1Cor 14:13: Wherefore let him that speaketh in an unknown tongue pray that he may interpret, 14: For if I pray in an unknown tongue, my spirit prayeth, but my understanding is unfruitful. 15: What is it then? I will pray with the spirit, and I will pray with the understanding also: I will sing with the spirit, and I will sing with the understanding also. precepts

Psalms: 47:6: Sing praises to God, sing praises: sing praises unto our King, sing praises. 7: For God is the King of all the earth: sing ye praises with understanding.

Col:3:15: And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to the which also ye are called in one body; and be ye thankful. 16: Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.

 (The WORD tell us to sing and pray with understanding: example- the song, goin up yonder to be with my lord. BUT the lord tell us, who has understanding, that the kingdom is coming down to EARTH.)

- 1Cor 14:16: Else when thou shalt bless with the spirit, how shall he that occupieth the room of the unlearned say Amen at thy giving of thanks, seeing he understandeth not what thou sayest? 17: For thou verily givest thanks well, but the other is not edified.
- Eph 4:29: Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth, but that which is good to the use of edifying, that it may minister grace unto the hearers. 30: And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.
- 2Tim 2:14: Of these things put them in remembrance, charging them before the Lord that they strive not about words to no profit, but to the subverting of the hearers.
- Ecc 12:9: And moreover, because the preacher was wise, he still taught the people knowledge; yea, he gave good heed, and sought out, and set in order many proverbs. 10: The preacher sought to find out acceptable words: and that which was written was upright, even words of truth.
 - (How can the church worship in the spirit, and praise GOD, but leave the church with no understanding of the Gospel that was preached, the congregation must be edified, in a room of the unlearned.) LIKE THE SAYING GO: ALL ON THE SAME PAGE
- 1Cor14:18: I thank my God, I speak with tongues more than ye all: 19: Yet in the church I had rather speak five words with my understanding, that by my voice I might teach others also, than ten thousand words in an unknown tongue. 27: If any man speak in an unknown tongue, let it be by two, or at the most by three, and that by course; and let one interpret.
- 1Cor 12:7: But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal. 8: For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit; 9: To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit; 10: To another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another divers kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues:
- 1Kings 4:29: And God gave Solomon wisdom and understanding exceeding much, and largeness of heart, even as the sand that is on the sea shore. 30: And Solomon's wisdom excelled the wisdom of all the children of the east country, and all the wisdom of Egypt.32: And he spake three thousand proverbs: and his songs were a thousand and five.
 - (The Lord blessed some with divers tongues, <u>meaning</u>, some that can speak more than one language, and some that can interpret divers tongues / languages. IN THE TRUTH!!)

1 CORINTHIANS CHAPTER 14: BREAKDOWN SPEAKING IN AN UNKNOWN TONGUE Edifying the church

• 1Cor 14:20: <u>Brethren</u>, <u>be not children in understanding</u>: howbeit in malice <u>be ye children</u>, <u>but in understanding</u> be men.

Heb:5:12: For when for the time ye ought to be teachers, <u>ye have need that one teach you again which be the first principles of the oracles of God; and are become such as have need of milk, and not of strong meat. 13: For every one that useth milk is unskilful in the word of righteousness: for he is a babe. 14: <u>But strong meat belongeth to</u> them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.</u>

1Pet 2:1: Wherefore laying aside all malice, and all guile, and hypocrisies, and envies, and all evil speakings, 2: As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby:

1Cor 13:8: Charity never faileth: but whether there be prophecies, they shall fail; whether there be tongues, they shall cease; whether there be knowledge, it shall vanish away. 9: For we know in part, and we prophesy in part. 10: But when that which is perfect is come, then that which is in part shall be done away. 11: When I was a child, I spake as a child, I understood as a child, I thought as a child; but when I became a man, I put away childish things.

- (The lord is the only one that gives knowledge, wisdom, and understanding. His word is like unto a baby in the beginning, you have to crawl, before you can walk, and a man that study and rightfully divide the scriptures, threw the word, he or she will, understand how to discern between, lawful and lawless, good and evil, damnation or salvation.) Charity never faileth
- 1Cor 14:22: Wherefore tongues are for a sign, not to them that believe, but to them that believe not: but prophesying serveth not for them that believe not, but for them which believe. 33: For God is not the author of confusion, but of peace, as in all churches of the saints. 37: If any man think himself to be a prophet, or spiritual, let him acknowledge that the things that I write unto you are the commandments of the Lord. 38: But if any man be ignorant, let him be ignorant. 39: Wherefore, brethren, covet to prophesy, and forbid not to speak with tongues.

 40: Let all things be done decently and in order.

John 18:20: Jesus answered him, I spake openly to the world; <u>I ever taught in the synagogue</u>, and in the temple, whither the Jews always resort; and in secret have I said nothing.

James 3:16: For where envying and strife is, there is confusion and every evil work.

17: But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, and easy to be intreated, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy. 18: And the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace of them that make peace.

 (The word teach us to edify an unknown tongue, and covet to prophesy and do all things in order.)
