

But in 1941, President Franklin D. Roosevelt named the third day of November as Thanksgiving Day. His purpose was to help business by making the shopping period between Thanksgiving and Christmas longer.

For thousands of years people in many lands have held harvest festivals. The American Thanksgiving probably grew out of the harvest-home celebration in England.

William B. Newell, a Penobscot Indian and former chairman of the Anthropology department at the University of Connecticut, noted that the first official Thanksgiving Day celebrated the massacre of 700 Indian men, women and children during one of their annual ceremonies. *"Thanksgiving Day" was first proclaimed by the Governor of the then Massachusetts Bay Colony in 1621 to commemorate the massacre of 700 men, women and children who were celebrating their annual Green Corn Dance*



As an annual celebration of the harvest and its bounty, moreover, Thanksgiving is placed under a category of festivals that spans cultures, continents and millennia. At various times, the Egyptians, Greeks and Romans feasted and paid tribute to their gods during the fall harvest

Some Native Americans and others take issue with how the Thanksgiving story is presented to the American public, and especially to schoolchildren. In their view, the traditional narrative paints a deceptively sunny portrait of relations between the Pilgrims and the Wampanoag people, masking the long and bloody history of conflict between Native Americans and European settlers that resulted in the deaths of millions. Since 1970, protesters have gathered on the day designated as Thanksgiving at the top of Cole's Hill, which overlooks Plymouth Rock, to commemorate a "National Day of Mourning." Similar events are held in other parts of the country.

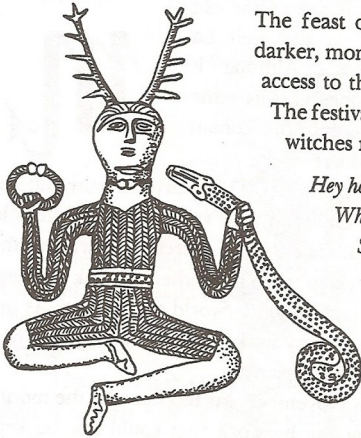

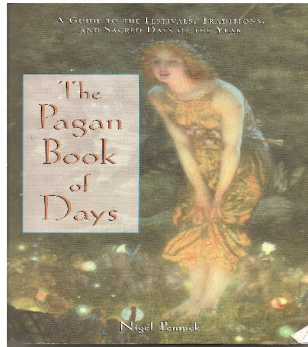
Samhain Eve/Halloween/Goddess month of Samhain commences

Hallowe'en: associated, through its name, with Eve. Popular secular observance of Halloween, for the night of October 31, is derived from the rites of celebrating the day of Saman, when the Lords called together the souls of the wicked who had died during the past year. The theme of the harvest, which runs through modern Halloween celebrations, comes from both druidic celebrations and the old Roman festival of Pomona, goddess of fruit, which were brought to Britain during the Roman occupation.

According to many scholars, **All Hallows' Eve** is a Christianized feast initially influenced by **Celtic harvest festivals**,^{[9][10]} with possible **pagan roots**, particularly the Gaelic **Samhain** ^{[11][12][13]} Other scholars maintain that it **originated independently of Samhain and has solely Christian roots.**^{[14][15]}

Typical festive Halloween activities include trick-or-treating (or the related "guising" or attending costume parties, decorating, carving pumpkins into jack-o'-lanterns, lighting bonfires, apple bobbing, **visiting haunted house attractions**, playing pranks, **telling scary stories** and **watching horror films**. In many parts of the world, the **Christian religious observances of All Hallows' Eve, including attending church services and lighting candles at the graves of the dead**, remain popular,^{[16][17][18]} although in other locations, these customs are less pronounced in favor of a more commercialized and secularized celebration.^{[19][20][21]} Because many Western Christian denominations encourage, although no longer require, abstinence from meat on All Hallows' Eve,^{[22][23]} the tradition of eating certain vegetarian foods for this vigil day developed, including the consumption of a colcannon, cider, potato pancakes, and soul cakes.^{[23][24][25]}

Contrary to popular belief, Mother's Day was not conceived and fine-tuned in the bowels of Hallmark. [The earliest tributes to mothers date back to the annual spring festival of the Greeks dedicated to Rhea, the mother of many deities](#), and to the offerings [ancient Romans made to their Great Mother of Gods, Cybele](#). [Christians celebrated this festival on the Sunday in Lent in honor of Mary](#), mother of Christ. In England this holiday was expected to include all mothers and [was called Mothering Sunday](#).

Early Beginnings

Mother's Day isn't a new holiday.

The earliest Mother's Day celebrations can be traced back to the spring celebrations of [ancient Greece](#) in honor of **Rhea**, the mother of the gods. [People would make offerings of honey-cakes, fine drinks, and flowers at dawn.](#)

The Romans also had a mother of all gods, **Magna Mater**, or **Great Mother**. [A temple was built in Rome for her](#). In March of each year, there was a celebration in her honor [called the Festival of Hilaria](#). Gifts were brought to the temple [to please the powerful mother-goddess](#).

In early traditions, she is known as "**the mother of gods**" and therefore is strongly associated with Gaia and Cybele, who have similar functions. [The classical Greeks saw her as the mother of the Olympian goddesses and gods](#), but not as an Olympian goddess in her own right. The Romans identified her with Magna Mater (their form of Cybele), and the Goddess Ops.

[In Rome](#), Cybele known as **Magna Mater** ("Great Mother") was adopted by the Roman State and developed a particular form of cult after the Sibylline oracle recommended her veneration as a religious component of Rome's second war against Carthage. [Roman mythographers reinvented her as a Trojan goddess](#)

[Celebrations of mothers and motherhood can be traced back to the ancient Greeks and Romans, who held festivals in honor of the mother goddesses Rhea and Cybele](#), but the clearest modern precedent for Mother's Day is the early Christian festival known as "Mothering Sunday." Once a major tradition in the United Kingdom and parts of Europe, [this celebration fell on the fourth Sunday in Lent](#) and was originally seen as a time when [faithful would return to their "mother church"](#)—the main church in the vicinity of their home—for a special service. Over time the [Mothering Sunday tradition shifted into a secular holiday](#), and children would present their mothers with flowers and other tokens of appreciation. [This custom eventually faded in popularity before merging with the American Mother's Day in the 1930s and 1940s.](#)

St. Valentine lost his head, but unfortunately it wasn't for love

How did a priest martyred for his faith in 3rd Century Rome become a symbol of romance for sweethearts the world over?

History says little of St. Valentine, the patron saint of lovers whose feast day is celebrated Wednesday. Scholars agree he was a priest and phy-

sician who lived in Rome during the reign of Claudius II. Arrested for aiding his fellow persecuted Christians, Valentine was beaten and beheaded about 270 A.D.

Yet Valentine's Day—with its traditions of Cupids, billets-doux, greeting cards, red roses and heart-shaped boxes of candy—has little to do with religion.

Rather, scholars believe the modern lovers' holiday has its roots in medieval lore. Recorded in some 14th Century English literature is the belief that birds choose their mates on Feb. 14. Because Christianized Europe venerated St. Valentine on that same day, religion and romance became inextricably linked.

Valentine's Day "has nothing

to do with St. Valentine at all," said Bruce Miller from the Catholic University of America in Washington and an expert on saints. "It's just called Valentine's Day."

The earliest example of a sweetheart referring to her par amour as Valentine is found in "The Paston Letters," a collection of personal and business correspondence between 1422

and 1529.

While most scholars are not convinced of the medieval origins of Valentine's Day, some scholars have argued otherwise. They suggest that early Christians established Valentine's feast day to counter pagan observances honoring Fel Juno, a Roman goddess of marriage and Lupercalia, an ancient Roman love festival.

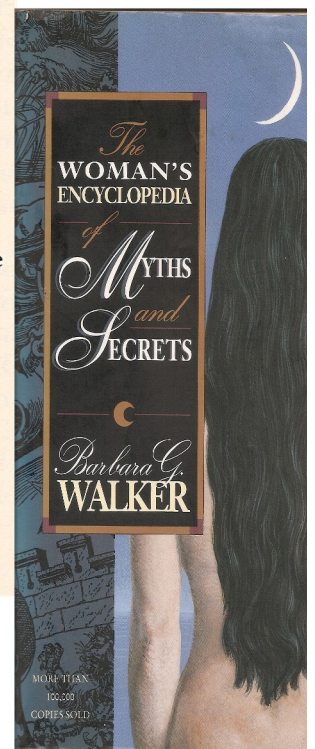
Valentine, Saint

The original Valentine's Day in the ides of February was Rome's Lupercalia, a festival of sexual license. Young men chose partners for erotic games by drawing "billets"—small papers—with women's names on them. Christians denounced these prototypical valentines as "heathens' lewd customs."¹ Churchmen tried to substitute saints' names and short sermons on the billets, but people soon reverted to the old love-notes.² February was sacred to Juno Februata, Goddess of the "fever" (*febris*) of love. The church replaced her with a mythical martyr, St. Valentine, who was endowed with several contradictory biographies. One of them made him a handsome Roman youth, executed at the very moment when his sweetheart received his billet of love.³

St. Valentine became a patron of lovers perforce, because the festival remained dedicated to lovers despite all official efforts to change it. Even in its Christianized form, the Valentinian festival involved secret sex worship, called "a rite of spiritual marriage with

angels in a nuptial chamber."⁴ Ordinary human beings engaged before witnesses in an act of sexual intercourse described as the marriage of Sophia and the Redeemer. A spoken formula said, in part, "Let the seed of light descend into thy bridal chamber, receive the bridegroom . . . open thine arms to embrace him. Behold, grace has descended upon thee."⁵

During the Middle Ages, St. Valentine was much invoked in love charms and potions, since he was a sketchily Christianized version of such love-gods as Eros, Cupid, Kama, Priapus, or Pan.

The general, or Arminian (see ARMINIANISM), Baptists trace their history from this date. The particular, or Calvinistic (see CALVINISM), Baptists arose about 1600. The two groups were united in England in 1644. Baptists who fled from England because of persecution (see DISSENTERS; NONCONFORMISTS) formed the nucleus of the Baptist movement in America. The first Baptist church in America was founded at Providence, R.I., in 1639 by Roger Williams (q.v.). A courageous advocate of religious freedom who defied the right of magistrates to interfere in matters of conscience and religion, Williams had been banished from Massachusetts Bay Colony (see MASSACHUSETTS

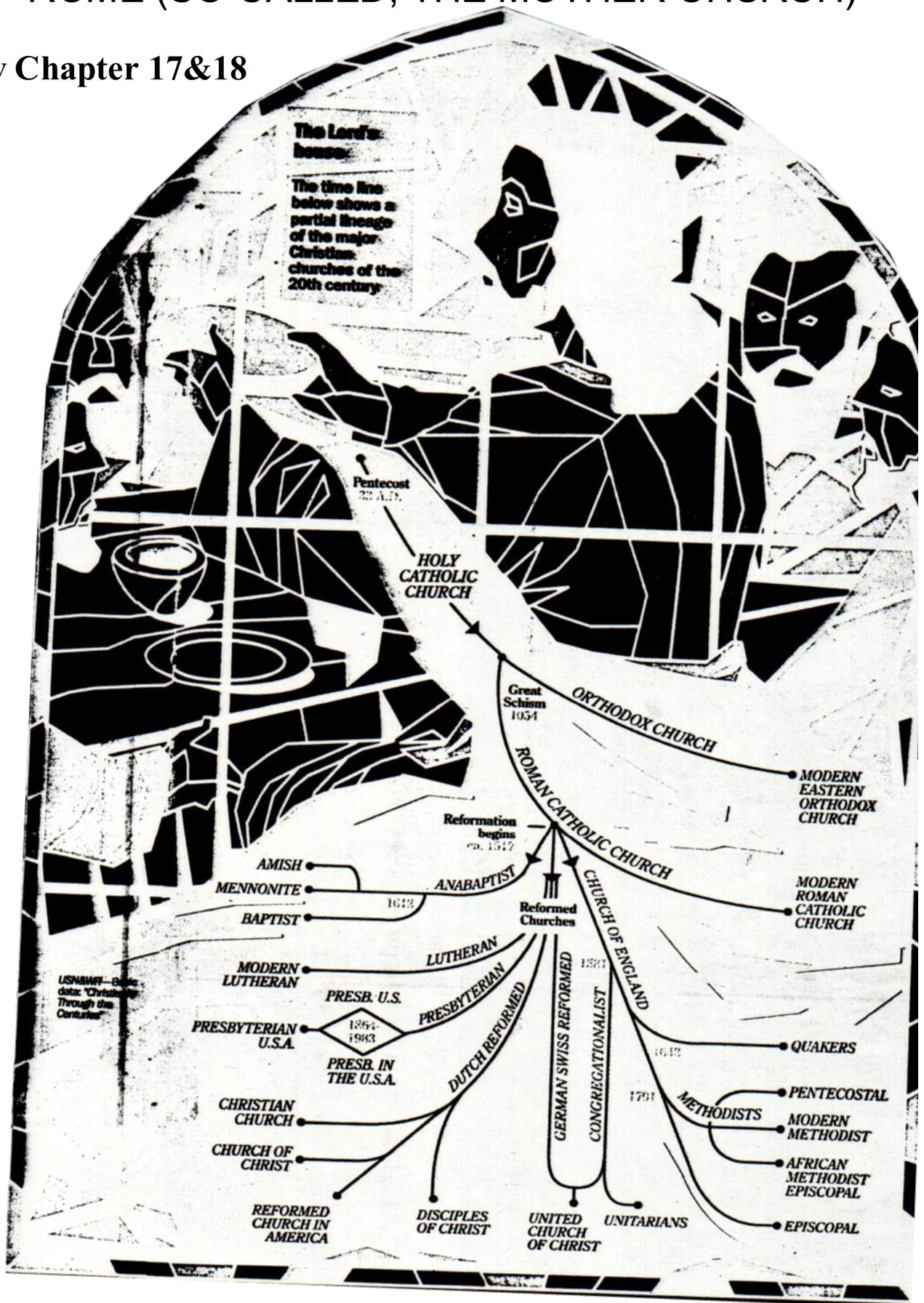

Augustus Caesar

September (the 7th month of the old Roman calendar) is named after the Roman goddess of fruit and fruit bearing trees.

Astraea

October (the 8th month of the old Roman calendar) is named after this Greek goddess.

Samhain

November (the 9th month of the old Roman calendar) is the first month of the winter quarter and gets its name from the festival of Samhain/All Saints.

Decima/Vesta

December (the 10th month of the old Roman calendar) is named after the middle goddess of the Three Fates, Decima (the Greek Vesta), she who personifies the present.

Janus

The two-faced Roman god of endings and beginnings. The New Year is celebrated in the month of January.

Februa

The Roman goddess of passion and love. Her orgiastic rites are celebrated on the 14th of February, St.Valentine's Day.

Mars

A Roman god (the Greek Ares) of war. March is named after him.

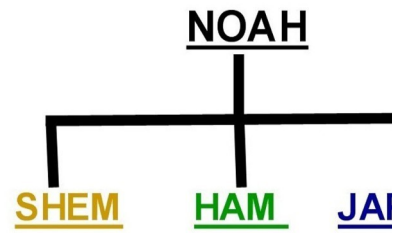

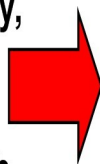
