THE 10 COMMANDMENTS

KJV

1 **EX:20:3:** THOU SHALT HAVE NO OTHER GODS BEFORE ME.

2 **EX:20:4:** THOU SHALT NOT MAKE UNTO THEE ANY GRAVEN IMAGE, OR ANY LIKENESS OF ANY THING THAT IS IN HEAVEN ABOVE, OR THAT IS IN THE EARTH BENEATH, OR THAT IS IN THE WATER UNDER THE EARTH: **5:** THOU SHALT NOT BOW DOWN THYSELF TO THEM, NOR SERVE THEM: FOR I THE LORD THY GOD AM A JEALOUS GOD, VISITING THE INIQUITY OF THE FATHERS UPON THE CHILDREN UNTO THE THIRD AND FOURTH GENERATION OF THEM THAT HATE ME; **6:** AND SHEWING MERCY UNTO THOUSANDS OF THEM THAT LOVE ME, AND KEEP MY COMMANDMENTS.

3 **EX:20:7:** THOU SHALT NOT TAKE THE NAME OF THE LORD THY GOD IN VAIN; FOR THE LORD WILL NOT HOLD HIM GUILTLESS THAT TAKETH HIS NAME IN VAIN.

4 **EX:20:8:** REMEMBER THE SABBATH DAY, TO KEEP IT HOLY. **9:** SIX DAYS SHALT THOU ABOUR, AND DO ALL THY WORK: **10:** BUT THE SEVENTH DAY IS THE SABBATH OF THE LORD THY GOD: IN IT THOU SHALT NOT DO ANY WORK, THOU, NOR THY SON, NOR THY DAUGHTER, THY MANSERVANT, NOR THY MAIDSERVANT, NOR THY CATTLE, NOR THY STRANGER THAT IS WITHIN THY GATES: **11:** FOR IN SIX DAYS THE LORD MADE HEAVEN AND EARTH, THE SEA, AND ALL THAT IN THEM IS, AND RESTED THE SEVENTH DAY: WHEREFORE THE LORD BLESSED THE SABBATH DAY, AND HALLOWED IT.

5 **EX:20:12:** HONOUR THY FATHER AND THY MOTHER: THAT THY DAYS MAY BE LONG UPON THE LAND WHICH THE LORD THY GOD GIVETH THEE.

6 **EX:20:13:** THOU SHALT NOT KILL.

7 **EX:20:14:** THOU SHALT NOT COMMIT ADULTERY.

8 **EX:20:15:** THOU SHALT NOT STEAL.

9 **EX:20:16:** THOU SHALT NOT BEAR FALSE WITNESS AGAINST THY NEIGHBOUR.

10 **EX:20:17:** THOU SHALT NOT COVET THY NEIGHBOUR'S HOUSE, THOU SHALT NOT COVET THY NEIGHBOUR'S WIFE, NOR HIS MANSERVANT, NOR HIS MAIDSERVANT, NOR HIS OX, NOR HIS ASS, NOR ANY THING THAT IS THY NEIGHBOUR'S.

Fear God: if you love God keep his Commandments 1 of 2

Ph'p 2:12: Wherefore, my beloved, as ye have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with **fear and trembling**.

Ecc 12:13: Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: **Fear God, and keep his commandments**: for this is the whole duty of man.

Deut 4:10: Specially the day that thou stoodest before the LORD thy God in Horeb, when the LORD said unto me, Gather me the people together, and I will make them hear my words, **that they may learn to fear me** all the days that they shall live upon the earth, and that they may teach their children.

2Cor 7:1: Having therefore these promises, dearly beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, **perfecting holiness in the fear of God**.

Psalms 64:9: **And all men shall fear**, and shall declare the work of God; for they shall wisely consider of his doing.

John 14:15: **If ye love me, keep my commandments** .

Gen 42:18: And Joseph said unto them the third day, **This do, and live; for I fear God**:

1Pet 3:15: But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts: and be ready always to give an answer to every man that asketh you a reason of the hope **that is in you with meekness and fear**:

2John 1:6: **And this is love**, that we **walk after his commandments**. This is the commandment, That, as ye have heard from the beginning, ye should walk in it.

Proverb 8:17: **I love them that love me**; and those that seek me early shall find me. **36**: But he that sinneth against me wrongeth **his own soul: all they that hate me love death**.

Rev 14:7: Saying with a loud voice, **Fear God, and give glory to him**; for the hour of his judgment is come: and worship him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters.

Hosea 3:5: Afterward shall the children of Israel return, and seek the LORD their God, and David their king; and **shall fear the LORD and his goodness in the latter days**.

Amos 3:8: The lion hath roared, **who will not fear?** the Lord GOD hath spoken, who can but prophesy?

Eph:5:20: Giving thanks always for all things unto God and the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ; **21: Submitting yourselves one to another in the fear of God**.

2Sam 23:3: The God of Israel said, the Rock of Israel spake to me, He that ruleth over men must be just, **ruling in the fear of God**.

Deut 6:2: **That thou mightest fear the LORD thy God, to keep all his statutes and his commandments**, which I command thee, thou, and thy son, and thy son's son, all the days of thy life; and that thy days may be prolonged. **13: Thou shalt fear the LORD thy God**, and serve him, and shalt swear by his name. **24**: And the LORD commanded us to do all these statutes, to **fear the LORD our God, for our good always**, that he might preserve us alive, as it is at this day.

Ex:20:6: And shewing mercy unto thousands **of them that love me, and keep my commandments**.

Luke 12:4: And I say unto you my friends, Be not afraid of them that kill the body, and after that have no more that they can do. **5: But I will forewarn you whom ye shall fear: Fear him**, which after he hath killed hath power to cast into hell; yea, **I say unto you, Fear him**. k.j.v.

Fear God: if you love God keep his Commandments 2 of 2

Joshua 4:24: That all the people of the earth might know the hand of the LORD, that it is mighty: **that ye might fear the LORD your God for ever.**

Acts 13:16: Then Paul stood up, and beckoning with his hand said, Men of Israel, **and ye that fear God**, give audience.

Psalms:40:3: And he hath put a new song in my mouth, even praise unto our God: **many shall see it, and fear, and shall trust in the LORD.**

Jonah 1:9: And he said unto them, I am an Hebrew; **and I fear the LORD**, the God of heaven, which hath made the sea and the dry land.

Ecc 3:14: I know that, whatsoever God doeth, it shall be for ever: nothing can be put to it, nor any thing taken from it: and **God doeth it, that men should fear before him.**

1John 2:3: And hereby we do know that we know him, **if we keep his commandments.** **4:** He that saith, **I know him, and keepeth not his commandments, is a liar**, and the truth is not in him. **5:** But whoso keepeth his word, in him **verily is the love of God perfected:** hereby know we that we are in him.

Deut 8:6: Therefore **thou shalt keep the commandments of the LORD thy God**, to walk in his ways, **and to fear him.**

2Chron 19:7: Wherefore now **let the fear of the LORD be upon you;** take heed and do it: for there is no iniquity with the LORD our God, nor respect of persons, nor taking of gifts.

Psalms 2:11: **Serve the LORD with fear, and rejoice with trembling.**

Romans 3:13: Their throat is an open sepulchre; with their tongues they have used deceit; the poison of asps is under their lips: **14:** Whose mouth is full of cursing and bitterness:

15: Their feet are swift to shed blood: **16:** Destruction and misery are in their ways:

17: And the way of peace have they not known: **18:** **There is no fear of God before their eyes.**

Luke 5:26: And they were all amazed, and they glorified God, **and were filled with fear,** saying, We have seen strange things to day.

Lev 25:17: Ye shall not therefore oppress one another; **but thou shalt fear thy God: for I am the LORD your God.**

1Pet 1:17: And if ye call on the Father, who without respect of persons judgeth according to every man's work, pass the time of your sojourning **here in fear:**

Deut 13:4: **Ye shall walk after the LORD your God, and fear him, and keep his commandments,** and obey his voice, and ye shall serve him, and cleave unto him.

Proverbs:13:13: Whoso despiseth the word shall be destroyed: **but he that feareth the commandment shall be rewarded.**

The Sabbath day (Saturday) seventh day

Gen 2: 1 Thus the heavens and the earth were finished, and all the host of them. **2** And on the **seventh day** God ended his work which he had made; and he rested on the **seventh day** from all his work which he had made. **3** And God blessed the seventh day, and sanctified it: because that in it he had rested from all his work which God created and made.

Ex 20: 11 For in six days the Lord made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them is, and rested the **seventh day**: wherefore the Lord blessed the **sabbath day**, and hallowed it.

Ex 20: 8 Remember the **sabbath day**, to keep it holy.

Ex 31: 16 Wherefore the children of Israel shall keep the **sabbath**, to observe the **sabbath** throughout their generations, for a perpetual covenant.

Deut 5: 12 Keep the **sabbath day** to sanctify it, as the Lord thy God hath commanded thee.

Isa 56: 2 Blessed is the man that doeth this, and the son of man that layeth hold on it; that keepeth the sabbath from polluting it, and keepeth his hand from doing any evil.

Isa 58: 13 If thou turn away thy foot from the **sabbath**, from doing thy pleasure on my holy day; and call the sabbath a delight, the holy of the Lord, honourable; and shalt honour him, not doing thine own ways, nor finding thine own pleasure, nor speaking thine own words:

Jer 17: 21 Thus saith the Lord; Take heed to yourselves, and bear no burden on the sabbath day, nor bring it in by the gates of Jerusalem;

Amos 8: 5 Saying, When will the new moon be gone, that we may sell corn? and the **sabbath**, that we may set forth wheat, making the ephah small, and the shekel great, and falsifying the balances by deceit?

Luke 6: 5 And he said unto them, That the Son of man is Lord also of the **sabbath**. **6** And it came to pass also on another **sabbath**, that he entered into the synagogue and taught: and there was a man whose right hand was withered.

Luke 4: 31 And came down to Capernaum, a city of Galilee, and taught them on the sabbath days.

Luke 14: 3 And Jesus answering spake unto the lawyers and Pharisees, saying, Is it lawful to heal on the sabbath day?

Mark 2: 27 And he said unto them, The **sabbath** was made for man, and not man for the **sabbath**: **28** Therefore the Son of man is Lord also of the **sabbath**.

John 9: 14 And it was the **sabbath day** when Jesus made the clay, and opened his eyes.

John 19: 31 The Jews therefore, because it was the preparation, that the bodies should not remain upon the cross on the sabbath day, (for that **sabbath day** was an high day,) besought Pilate that their legs might be broken, and that they might be taken away.

Matt 28: 1 In the end of the **sabbath**, as it began to dawn toward the first day of the week, came Mary Magdalene and the other Mary to see the sepulchre.

Acts 13: 42 And when the Jews were gone out of the synagogue, the Gentiles besought that these words might be preached to them the next sabbath. **43** Now when the congregation was broken up, many of the Jews and religious proselytes followed Paul and Barnabas: who, speaking to them, persuaded them to continue in the grace of God. **44** And the next **sabbath day** came almost the whole city together to hear the word of God.

Acts 15: 21 For Moses of old time hath in every city them that preach him, being read in the synagogues every **sabbath day**.

Acts 17: 2 And Paul, as his manner was, went in unto them, and three **sabbath days** reasoned with them out of the scriptures,

Col 2: 16 Let no man therefore judge you in meat, or in drink, or in respect of an holyday, or of the new moon, or of the **sabbath days**:

John 17:5 And now, O Father, glorify thou me with thine own self with the glory which I had with thee **before the world was.**

Gen 22:15 And the angel of the LORD called unto Abraham out of heaven the second time,

Gen 22:16 And said, By myself have I sworn, saith the LORD, for because thou hast done this thing, and hast not withheld thy son, thine only son:

Gen 22:17 That in blessing I will bless thee, and in multiplying I will multiply thy **seed** as the stars of the heaven, and as the sand which is upon the sea shore; and thy **seed** shall possess the gate of his enemies;

Gen 22:18 And in thy **seed** shall all the nations of the earth be blessed; because thou hast obeyed my voice.

Gal 3:16 Now to Abraham and his **seed** were the promises made. He saith not, And to seeds, as of many; **but as of one**, And to thy **seed**, which is Christ.

Gal 3:29: And if ye be Christ's, then are ye Abraham's **seed**, and heirs according to the promise.

Heb 1:2 Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, **by whom also he made the worlds;**

Pray toward this place / land / the Holy City

1 kings 8: 29 That thine eyes may be open toward this house night and day, even toward the place of which thou hast said, My name shall be there: that thou mayest hearken unto the prayer which thy servant shall make toward this place. **30** And hearken thou to the supplication of thy servant, and of thy people Israel, when they shall pray toward this place: and hear thou in heaven thy dwelling place: and when thou hearest, forgive.

1 kings 8:35 When heaven is shut up, and there is no rain, because they have sinned against thee; if they pray toward this place, and confess thy name, and turn from their sin, when thou afflictest them

Daniel 6: 10 Now when Daniel knew that the writing was signed, he went into his house; and his windows being open in his chamber toward Jerusalem, he kneeled upon his knees three times a day, and prayed, and gave thanks before his God, as he did aforetime.

2 chronicles 6: 20 That thine eyes may be open upon this house day and night, upon the place whereof thou hast said that thou wouldest put thy name there; to hearken unto the prayer which thy servant prayeth toward this place. **21** Hearken therefore unto the supplications of thy servant, and of thy people Israel, which they shall make toward this place: hear thou from thy dwelling place, even from heaven; and when thou hearest, forgive.

2 chronicles 6: 26 When the heaven is shut up, and there is no rain, because they have sinned against thee; yet if they pray toward this place, and confess thy name, and turn from their sin, when thou dost afflict them;

1 kings 8: 38 What prayer and supplication soever be made by any man, or by all thy people Israel, which shall know every man the plague of his own heart, and spread forth his hands toward this house:

1 kings 8: 42 (For they shall hear of thy great name, and of thy strong hand, and of thy stretched out arm;) when he shall come and pray toward this house;

2 chronicles 6: 34 If thy people go out to war against their enemies by the way that thou shalt send them, and they pray unto thee toward this city which thou hast chosen, and the house which I have built for thy name;

Zechariah 8: 3 Thus saith the Lord; I am returned unto Zion, and will dwell in the midst of Jerusalem: and Jerusalem shall be called a city of truth; and the mountain of the Lord of hosts the holy mountain.

Isa 27: 13 And it shall come to pass in that day, that the great trumpet shall be blown, and they shall come which were ready to perish in the land of Assyria, and the outcasts in the land of Egypt, and shall worship the Lord in the holy mount at Jerusalem.

Joel 2: 1 Blow ye the trumpet in Zion, and sound an alarm in my holy mountain: let all the inhabitants of the land tremble: for the day of the Lord cometh, for it is nigh at hand;

1 kings 8: 48 And so return unto thee with all their heart, and with all their soul, in the land of their enemies, which led them away captive, and pray unto thee toward their land, which thou gavest unto their fathers, the city which thou hast chosen, and the house which I have built for thy name: **49** Then hear thou their prayer and their supplication in heaven thy dwelling place, and maintain their cause,

Ezekiel 21: 2 Son of man, set thy face toward Jerusalem, and drop thy word toward the holy places, and prophesy against the land of Israel,

40 Days / Yrs

Deut: 10:10: And I stayed in the mount, according to the first time, **forty days and forty nights**; and the LORD hearkened unto me at that time also, and the LORD would not destroy thee

Luke 4:2: **Being forty days tempted of the devil.** And in those days he did eat nothing: and when they were ended, he afterward hungered.

Gen: 7:12: And the rain was upon the earth **forty days and forty nights.**

Ex: 34:28: And he was there with the LORD **forty days and forty nights**; he did neither eat bread, nor drink water. And he wrote upon the tables the words of the covenant, the ten commandments.

Nehemiah 9:21: **Yea, forty years didst thou sustain them in the wilderness**, so that they lacked nothing; their clothes waxed not old, and their feet swelled not.

Deut:2:7: For the LORD thy God hath blessed thee in all the works of thy hand: he knoweth thy walking through this great wilderness: these forty years the LORD thy God hath been with thee; thou hast lacked nothing.

Ex: 16:35: And the children of Israel did eat manna **forty years**, until they came to a land inhabited; they did eat manna, until they came unto the borders of the land of Canaan.

Num: 14:33: And your children shall wander in the wilderness **forty years**, and bear your whoredoms, until your carcases be wasted in the wilderness. **34:** After the number of the days in which ye searched the land, even forty days, each day for a year, shall ye bear your iniquities, even **forty years**, and ye shall know my breach of promise.

Num: 13:25: And they returned from searching of the land after **forty days.**

2 Sam: 15:7: And it came to pass after **forty years**, that Absalom said unto the king, I pray thee, let me go and pay my vow, which I have vowed unto the LORD, in Hebron.

1Kings 11:42: And the time that Solomon reigned in Jerusalem over all Israel was **forty years.**

1Chron: 29:26: Thus David the son of Jesse reigned over all Israel. **27:** And the time that he **reigned over Israel was forty years**; seven years reigned he in Hebron, and thirty and three years reigned he in Jerusalem.

Jonah 3:4: And Jonah began to enter into the city a day's journey, and he cried, and said, Yet **forty days**, and Nineveh shall be overthrown.

Gen: 50:3: And **forty days were fulfilled for him**; for so are fulfilled the days of those which are embalmed: and the Egyptians mourned for him threescore and ten days.

Matt:4:2: And when he had fasted **forty days and forty nights**, he was afterward an hungred.

Acts 1:3: To whom also he shewed himself alive after his passion by many infallible proofs, **being seen of them forty days**, and speaking of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God:

1Kings 19:8: And he arose, and did eat and drink, and went in the strength of that meat **forty days and forty nights** unto Horeb the mount of God.

Ps 56: 1 Be merciful unto me, O God: for man would swallow me up; he fighting **daily** oppresseth me.

Ps 61: 8 So will I sing praise unto thy name for ever, that I may **daily** perform my vows.

Prov 8: 34 Blessed is the man that heareth me, watching **daily** at my gates, waiting at the posts of my doors.

Isa 58: 2 Yet they seek me **daily**, and delight to know my ways, as a nation that did righteousness, and forsook not the ordinance of their God: they ask of me the ordinances of justice; they take delight in approaching to God. **3** Wherefore have we fasted, say they, and thou seest not? wherefore have we afflicted our soul, and thou takest no knowledge? Behold, in the day of your fast ye find pleasure, and exact all your labours.

Act 2: 46 And they, continuing **daily** with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, did eat their meat with gladness and singleness of heart, **47** Praising God, and having favour with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved.

Heb 3: 13 But exhort one another **daily**, while it is called To day; lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin.

Ps 13: 1 How long wilt thou forget me, O Lord? for ever? how long wilt thou hide thy face from me? **2** How long shall I take counsel in my soul, having sorrow in my heart **daily**? how long shall mine enemy be exalted over me? **3** Consider and hear me, O Lord my God: lighten mine eyes, lest I sleep the sleep of death;
